Personification poem

Students write a personification style poem using a supplied pattern. Completed poems are published and illustrated using Flickr

Grade level:

6-8

Subjects:

Language Arts, Technology

Topic:

Poetry

Time needed:

One class period to introduce and write poetry. Two class periods to practice Flickr skills and publish individual poetry.

Materials:

Personification poem, pattern worksheet, use of a computer, Internet Access
Flickr Tools - <http://bighugelabs.com/flickr/> - Slideshow

Objectives:

Students understand the definition of personification and can identify its use.

Students can determine when to use personification in their writing.

Students understand working with the following Flickr Tools to publish their poem

Students will use the Personification Poem Template to write their poem.

Students will use Flickr to search for photos that represent each line of their poem.

Students will use Flickr Tools Slideshow to create a Slide Show of their Poem
